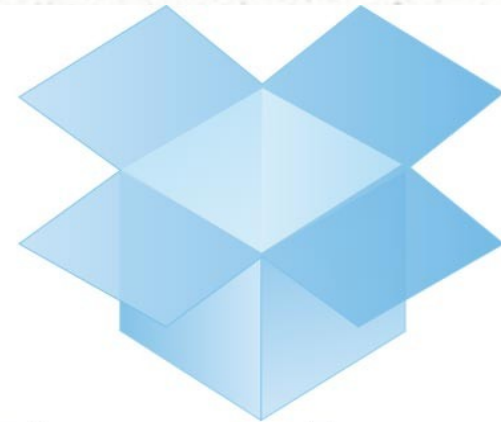
- Cloud Based Storage

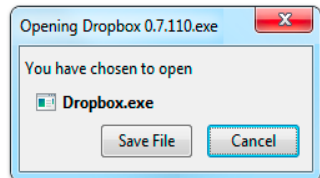

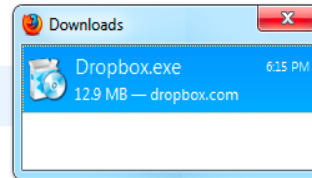
Downloading Dropbox...

1. Save the Dropbox application

Click **Save File** when prompted.



2. Open the Dropbox Installer

From your browser's Downloads window, double click the `.exe` file that just downloaded.



3. Follow Setup Instructions

Follow the instructions to get Dropbox set up on your computer and you will be good to go!



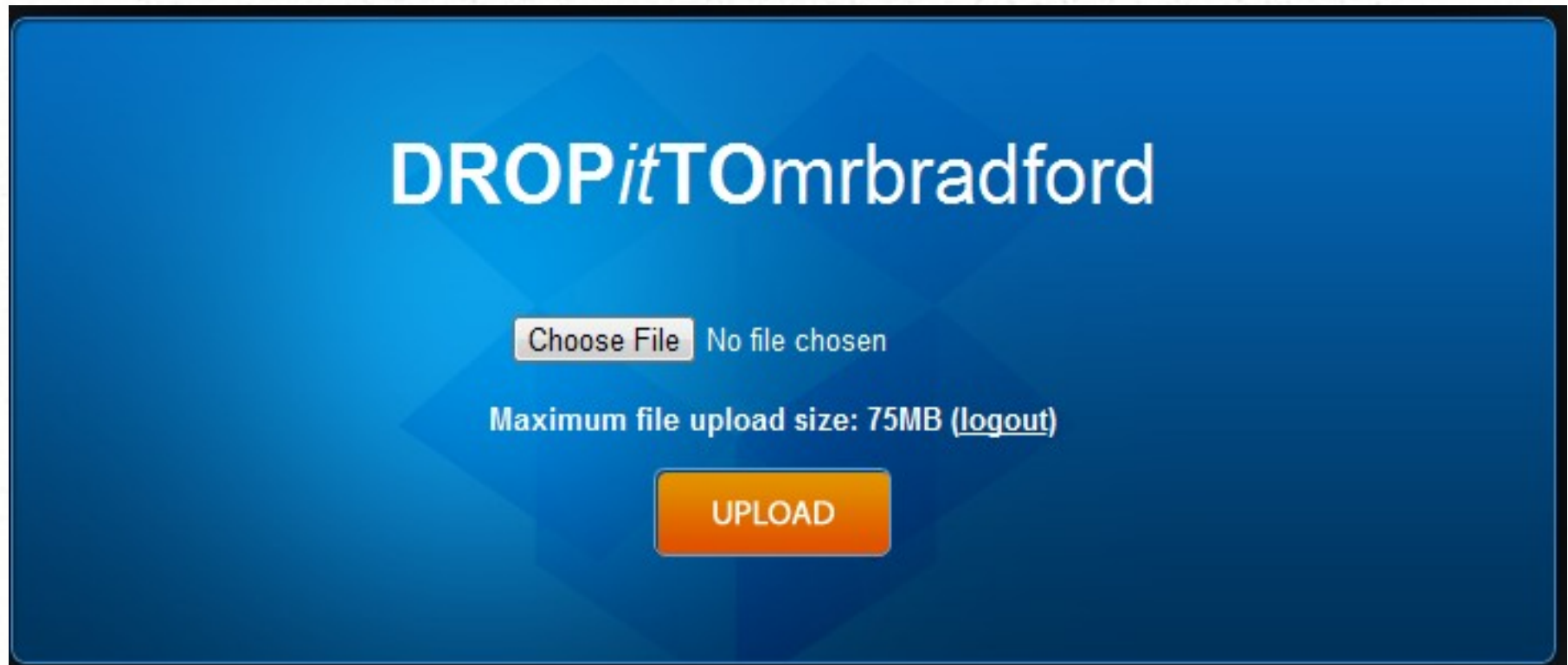

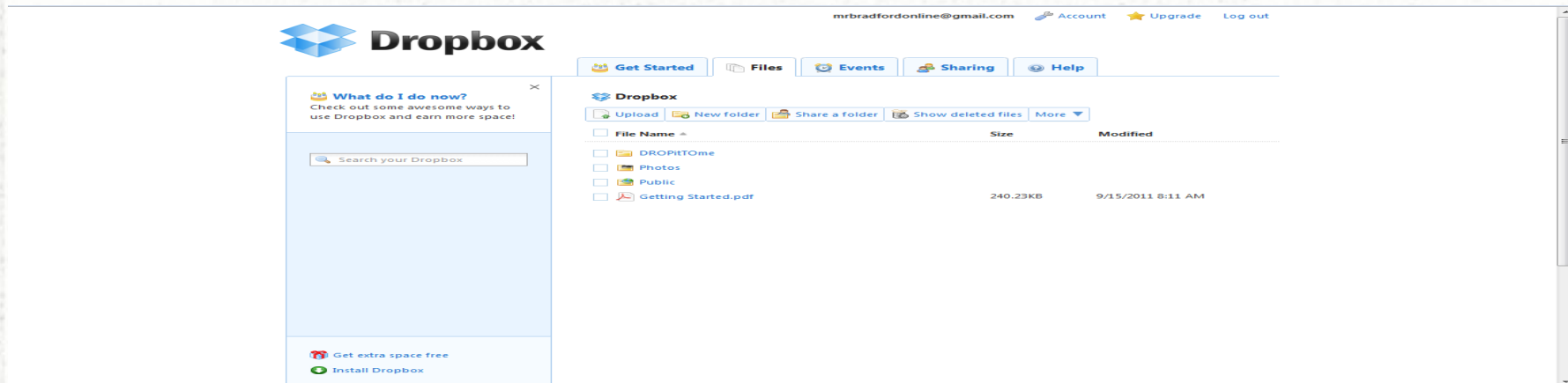

Students click on Choose File and then select the file they want to upload and then click upload.
