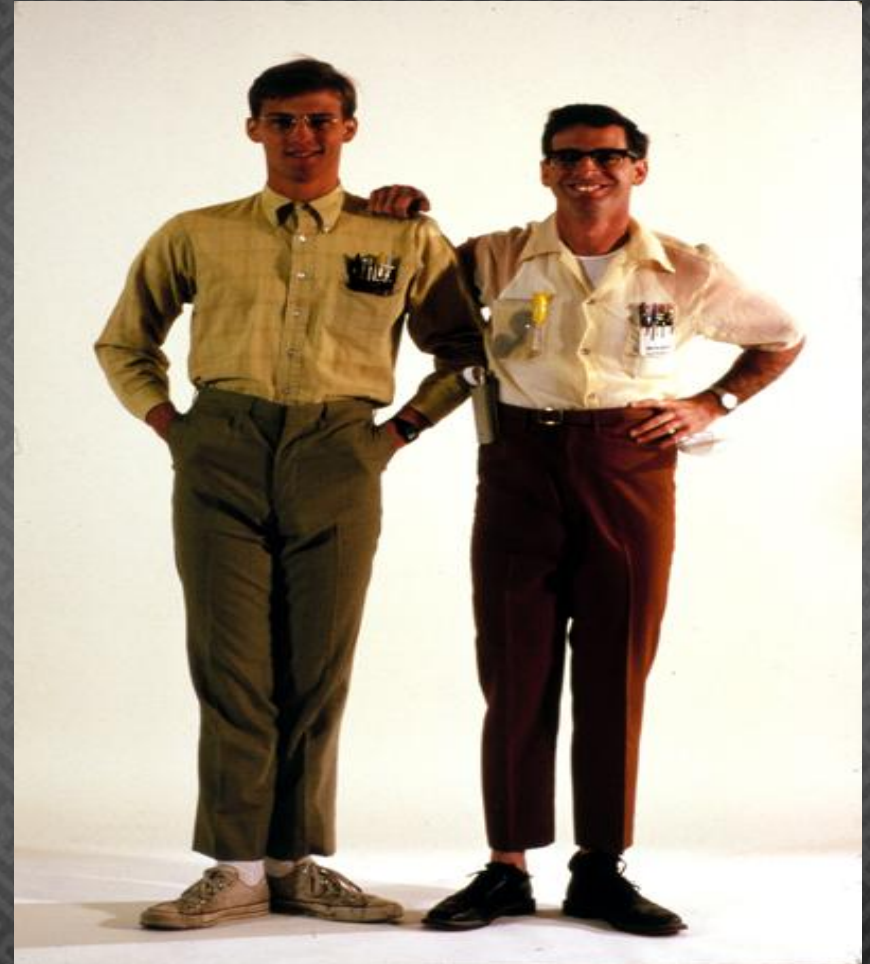
So what took so long?

The Nerd Stuff

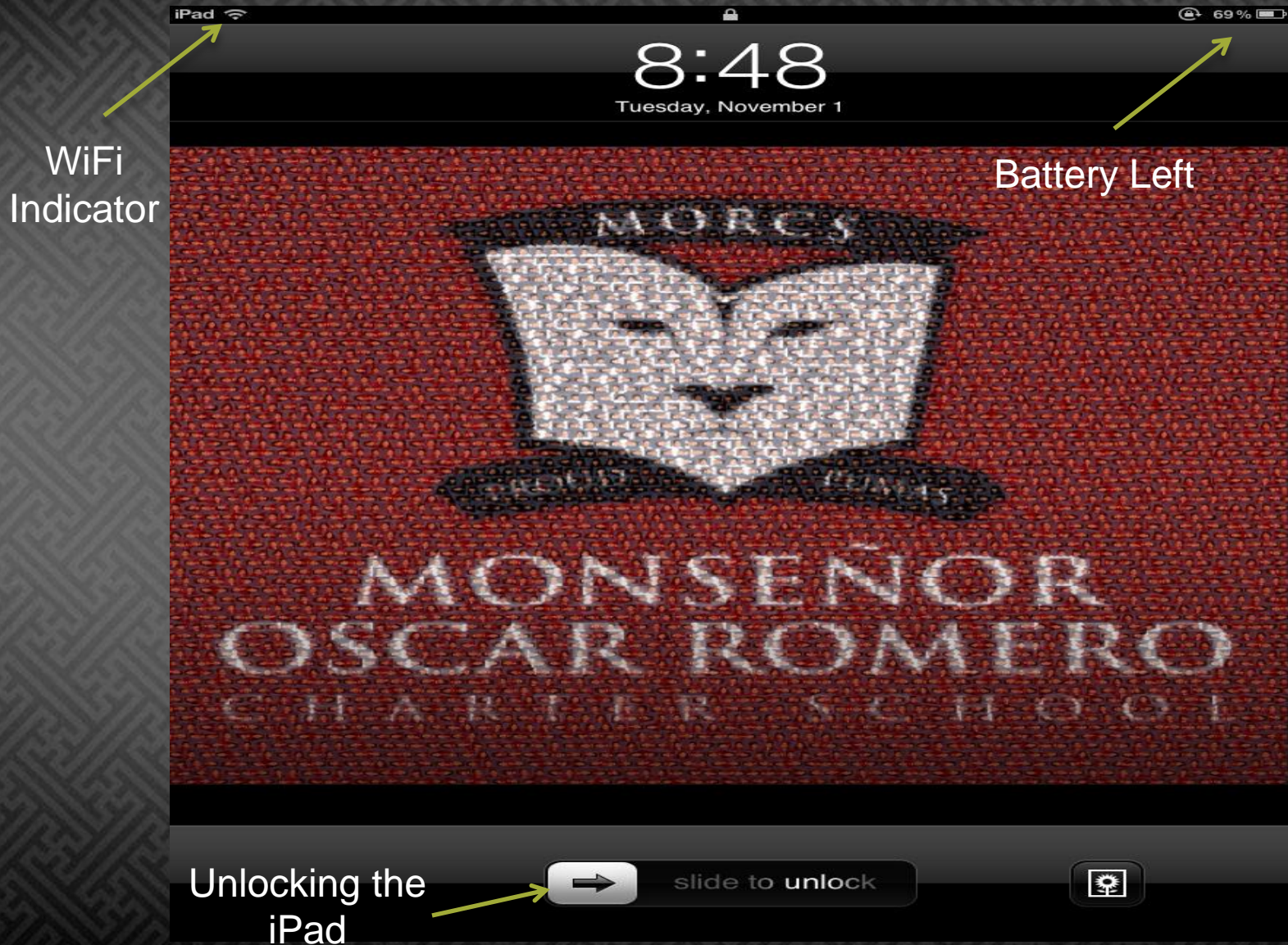
- 15 16gb WiFi Only iPad2s

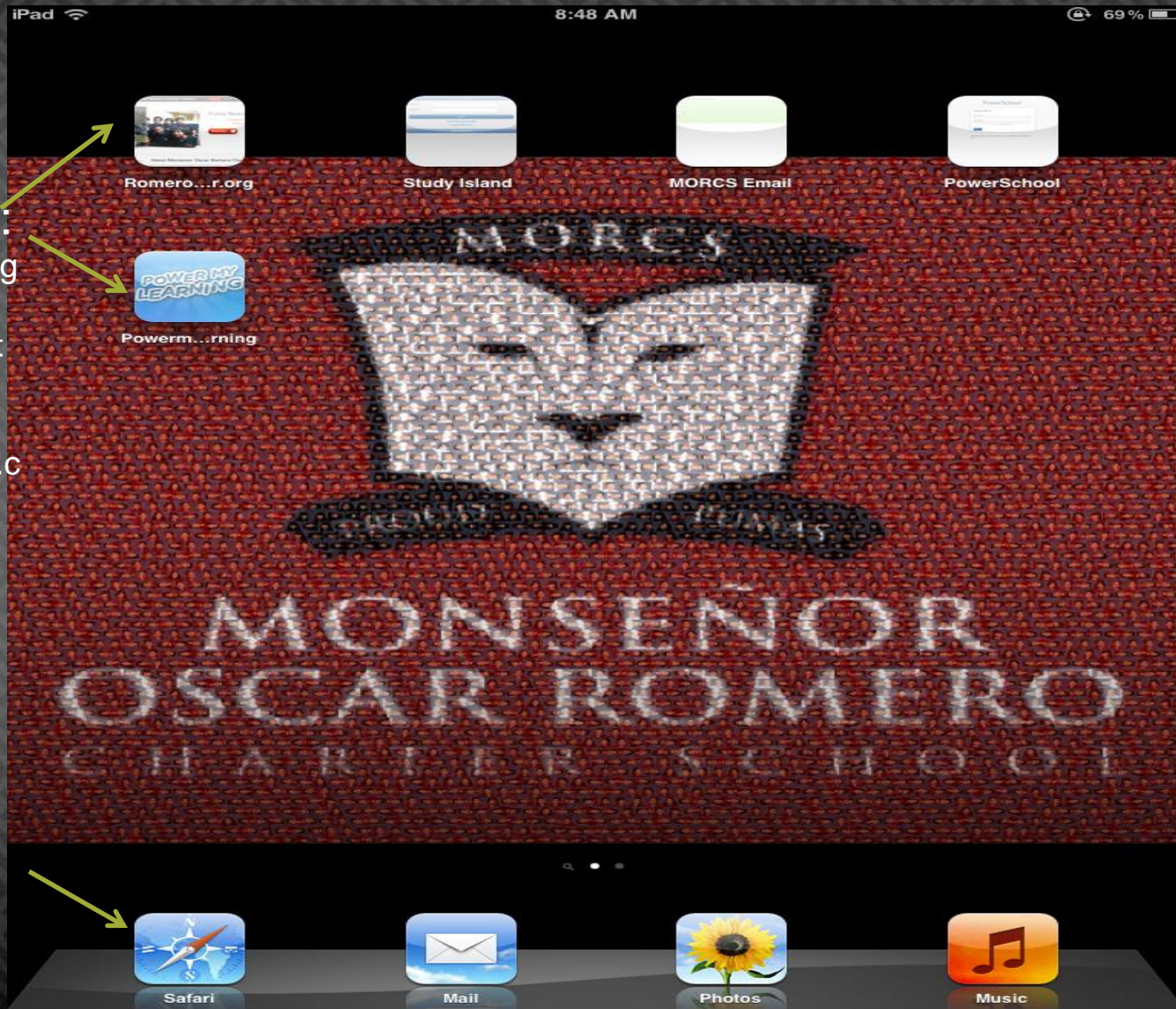


The Lock Screen

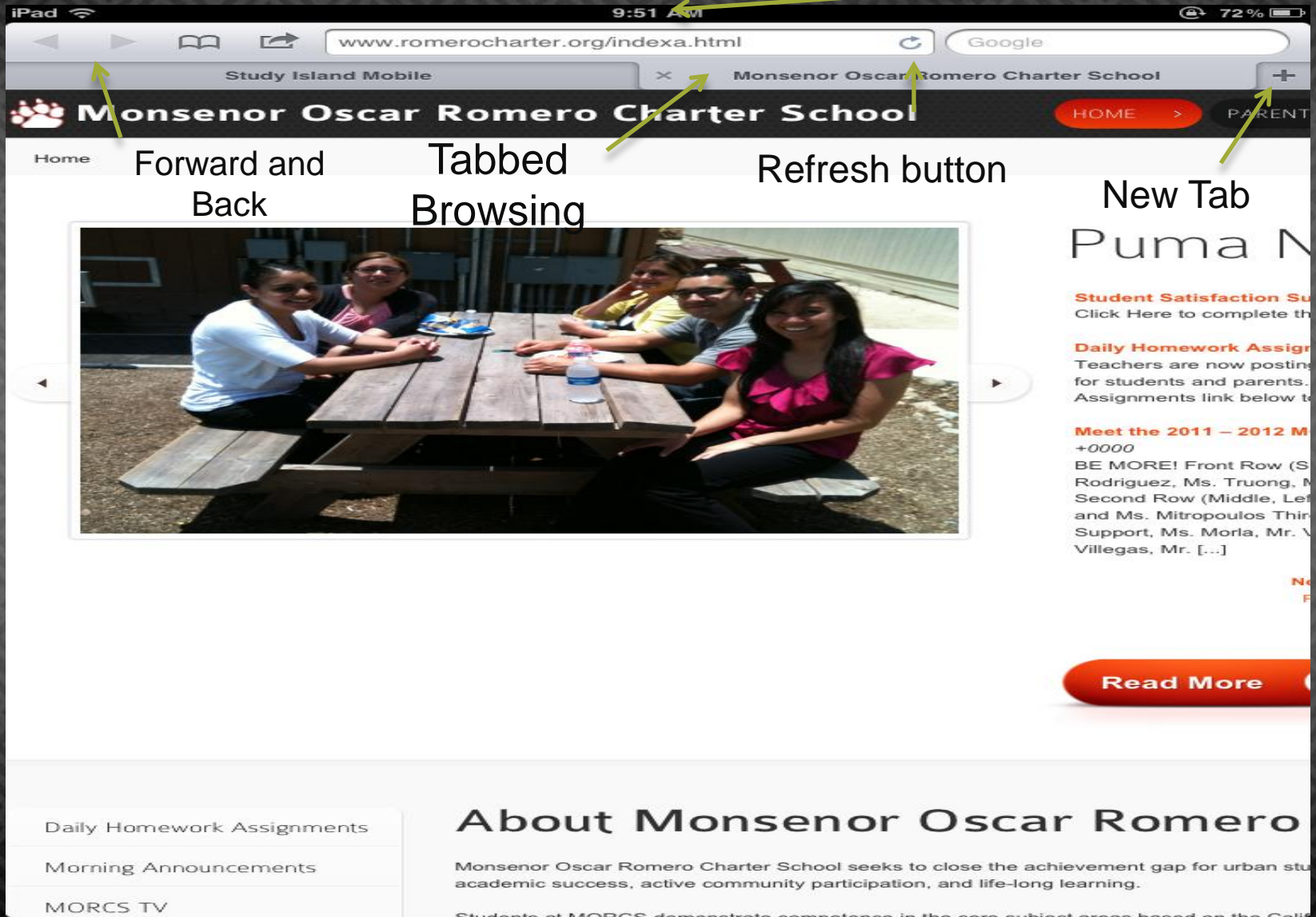
Internet Browsing

- The iPad can be used as an internet browser just like the browser on your computer
- iPads do not support Flash. (i.e. Aleks, some games, websites)
- Try and search for HTML5 alternatives (Google html5 adding and subtracting games)



Safari Basics

Quick Tip:" To quickly get to the top of a webpage, email, etc click on the time at the top of the iPad.

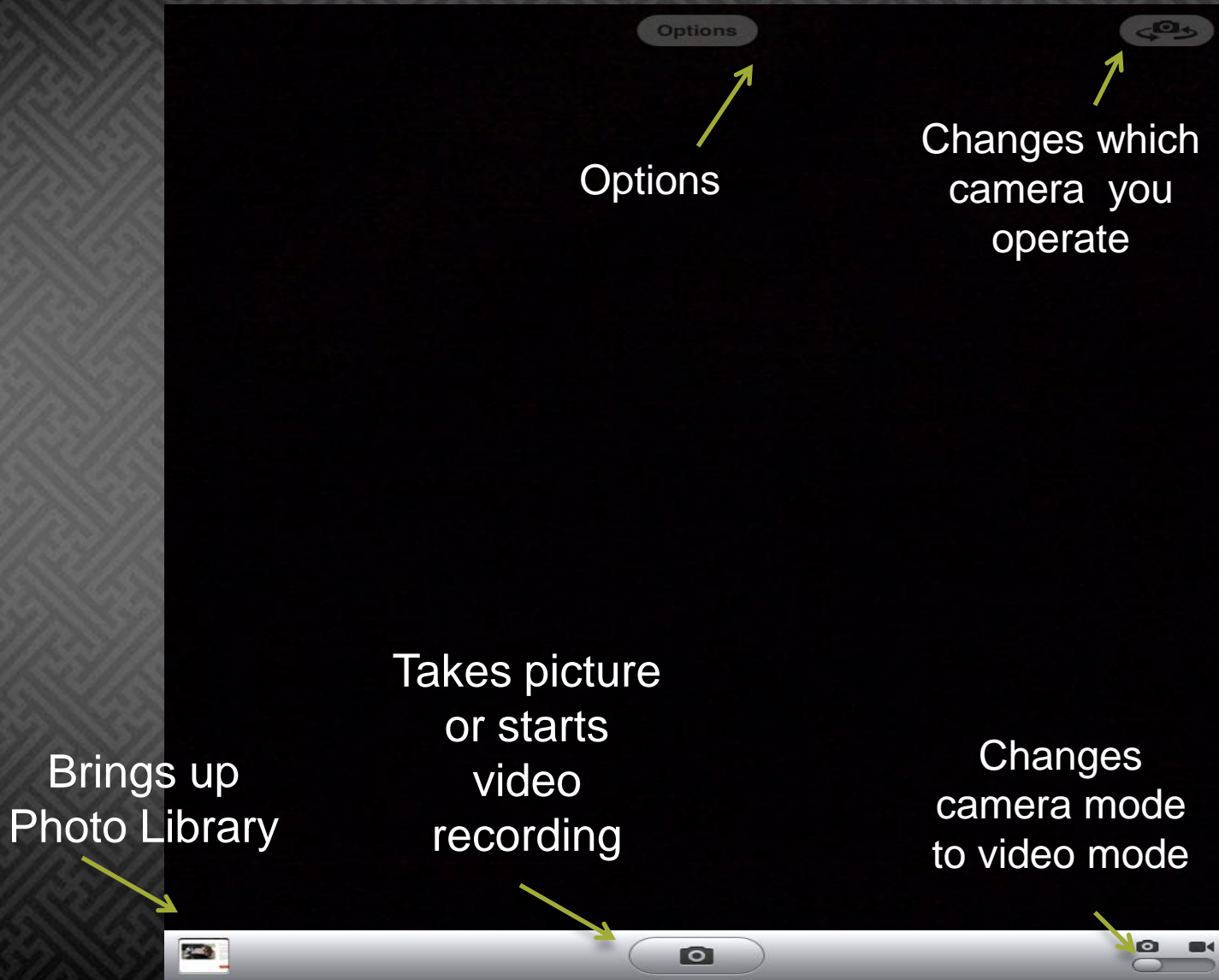


iPad Safari Basics

- Scrolling: Drag your finger up and down
- Zooming: Pinch your fingers together or apart
- Isolate: Double tap on a picture or text to “isolate” or highlight that item

- Wifi Dependent. No 3g
- Not Flash enabled
- Some apps have been removed/moved to avoid student distractions

How can I use the iPads in my classroom?

- Internet Browsing
- Student created presentations
- ShowMe (App) - Student created screencasts
- Evernote (Website and App)– Notes stored in the cloud
- Virtual Dissections

How can I use the iPads in my classroom?

- Google Apps (email, maps, docs, etc)
- Student created E-Books
(<http://goo.gl/Tobl5>)
- Student created content.
- iBooks (App) - Many of the classics are free!
- Mathboard (App) – Basic facts practice

How can I request the iPads?

- Fill out the Technology Request Calendar on Google Calendars.
- The iPads will be checked out for the whole day on a first come first serve basis.
- If you would like to share the iPads with another teacher please remember that the teacher who checks them out is accountable for the iPads.

My day with the iPads

- You will need to personally get the iPads before school. iPads will not be checked out to a student.
- Fill out the check out form found in the iPad binder.
- When returning the iPads you will need to personally bring them back. Do not allow students to bring the iPads back .
